Lunch break arrangements

- Remember children will be at school until 2pm and will be hungry by lunch time- please ensure you send in a well packed and nutritious lunch box
- Could you please make sure that the boxes clearly labeled with your child's name and have a cooler block inside if necessary

H1N1 precautions (More detailed information regards the precautions are posted on this website and will also be handed out at school)

- Everyone that enters the school gates will have their temperature taken and recorded
- Parents /nannies/ children must report to the school hall upon arrival to have their temperature taken
- No-one will be allowed to enter the class room without having had their temperature taken
- Adults over 37.8 will not be allowed into the class, children over 37.8 will be sent home.
